Each session is worth one-half unit of credit. A maximum of one unit may be earned during summer school. Students will be required to enroll in the 1st session if they failed the first semester of the course. Students will be required to enroll in the 2nd session if they failed the second semester. Either an unofficial copy of your transcript or a letter from your counselor indicating what course you need to take must accompany your enrollment forms. **NO EXCEPTIONS!**

ATTENDANCE: Attendance is mandatory. There will be no provisions made for vacations, camps, or “special situations.” There are no “excused” or “unexcused” absences. Any student with more than 12 hours of absences per session will be dropped. Tuition will not be refunded. Each day equals 5 hours of absences.
